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Dr. Silviu Polosan was born in Blaj, Romania, on 03/01/1968. Graduated “I. Muresianu”, math-physics high school Blaj, Alba, Romania in 1986, Faculty of Physics, Bucharest-Romania in 1993 and PhD between 1997-2002 Faculty of Physics, Bucharest-Romania.

As work experience, he was employed as Research Assistant in 1993 at National Institute of Materials Physics, Optics and Spectroscopy department. He is now Senior Researcher I (Professor) at National Institute of Materials Physics from 2015, Functional Nanostructures as Chief of Department. Co-author at more than 100 scientific papers with an $h=18$. The main field of activities are related to organic light emitting diodes, semiconductors, glass-ceramic oxides, metallic thin films for electrodes applications.
